## **FACT's Fund-a-Farmer Grants**

Since 2012 FACT has awarded 157 grants to farmers totaling \$355,940 to improve farm animal welfare, expand humane farming, and support capital and operational work done on dozens of farms. In 2019 alone we distributed over \$94,000 to 38 farms.
